You are invited to present your research as an Oral presentation at the American College of Physicians, Michigan Chapter Associates Day Meeting on May 14, 2010 at the at the Auburn Hills Marriott Pontiac at Centerpoint, Pontiac, MI

You must be an associate of ACP and you must register for the meeting to present. Your presentation is scheduled for Friday May 14, 2010, beginning at 10:00 am. The following instructions are provided to help you with developing your presentation and facilitate the smooth transition from one presentation to another.

The total duration of your presentation will be 12 minutes. Please leave a minimum of 2 minutes for questions. Responses to questions posed by judges and audience members are very important in evaluating your presentation. Moderators will strictly enforce time and you will be asked to cut short your presentation if you exceed 12 minutes.

Your slides must be in Microsoft PowerPoint and stored on a USB flash drive. Please have at least one additional back up copy with you in another USB flash drive or CD media. You will be asked to load your presentations on to the computer before your session gets under way. We are not able to display presentations that are on your own laptop computers.

A panel of three judges will score your presentation. Please review the scoring worksheet that will be used by the judges based on the type of your presentation. You should make it a point to address all of the areas for which scores are assigned in order to score well.
