You are invited to present your research as a poster presentation at the American College of Physicians, Michigan Chapter Associates Day Meeting on May 14, 2010 at the at the Auburn Hills Marriott Pontiac at Centerpoint, Pontiac, MI

You must be an associate of ACP and you must register for the meeting to present. The following instructions are provided to help you with developing your poster and preparing to present your poster for on-site judging.

Your poster should be on display for the total duration of the meeting. **Set-up is scheduled for Friday morning beginning at 7:00 a.m. The judging will begin promptly at 8:00 a.m. Please have your poster displayed by this time.**

Your poster must not exceed 4' x 4' in size. Larger posters may not fit within the tack boards available for display. Your poster will be judged by two judges. You must be present by your poster in order to describe your poster to the judges. If you are not by your poster when the judges come by, your poster may not be scored. Please stay by your poster for the entire judging period as the judges may return for additional review.

Due to limited time, judges have about 6 minutes to review your poster. Practice presenting a summary of your research in 4-5 minutes and leave 1-2 minutes for questions.

Please review the scoring worksheet that will be used by the judges based on the type of your presentation. You should make it a point to address all of the areas when you prepare and present your poster in order to score well.
