### Student Presentations at ACP Michigan Chapter Annual Meeting

The Michigan Chapter of the American College of Physicians (ACP) is sponsoring a **STUDENT PRESENTATION SESSION** at its upcoming Regional Meeting at the Grand Traverse Resort in Acme, MI on September 25-27, 2009. We are inviting reflective or creative submissions for display and discussion. Students from Michigan's medical schools are invited to submit pieces no later than September 1, 2009.

#### Submission Options:

##### Abstracts for poster or oral presentation:

- **Research**
- **Traditional Clinical Vignette:** Description of new condition, illness or disease; description of patient with an unusual presentation of a common illness or disease; or an unusual or rare disease or condition.

Oral/Essay/Creative submission (please limit submission to no more than two pages using 12 fonts). Students are encouraged to be creative in use of topics and format.

- **Research**
- **Traditional Clinical Vignette**
- **“My First Patient”**
- **“A Patient I will Always Remember”** (Note: patient may have been seen in the in-patient setting, out-patient setting, or during service or volunteer activities).
- **“The Kind of Physician I Would Like to Be” or “Dr. \_\_\_\_\_: A Physician Role Model for Me”**
- **Poetry** related to medicine or humanistic medicine
- **Art work** related to medicine or humanistic medicine such as drawing, photos, etc. Note: short accompanying narratives that describe or explain the artwork are welcome.
- **Other artistic submissions** are encouraged (e.g. videos, music)

#### **Format and Process:**

Students should send submissions via email attachment to Marty Muth at [muthm@msu.edu](mailto:muthm@msu.edu) by the September 1, 2009 deadline. If a poster is being prepared, only the abstract should be submitted. If a written narrative is submitted, it should be no longer than two pages in 12 pt font. Submissions will be limited to one in each category – Abstracts and Creative per student.
